Presenting your research and data at our scientific poster session is a great opportunity to showcase your research results and data. This is also a great venue to meet and network with conference participants. Faculty, residents and medical students as well as representatives of organizations are invited to present and share your important industry data during this Scientific Poster Session.

*ALL Poster presenters will need to be registered and attend meetings in person.*

**POSTER GUIDELINES:** Abstracts should contain no more than 600 words. Present numerical data in the form of graphs, rather than tables (graphs make trends in the data much more evident). If data must be presented in table-form, Keep it Simple Avoid acronyms and extensive mathematical notations as much as possible. The abstract should include complete details of the contestant (e.g., abstract title, name, affiliation, abstract etc). Poster dimension no larger than 36 by 48 inches landscape. Conference will provide poster stand and poster board. Abstracts accepted for the presentation will be notified through email and published online.

#### **POSTER COMPETITION (LIMITED TO RESIDENTS AND STUDENTS ONLY)**

**Eligibility:** This competition is open to all students Graduates, Postgraduates and Research Scholars, residents, physicians. Presenters must register online to attend conferences to present their poster at the conference. If the registered presenter is unable to attend the conference, he/she may send a substitute. Previous posters submitted are not eligible. The winners will be announced at the closing ceremony of the conference. The decision of the winner will be withdrawn if the winner/winners is/are not present at the time of announcement.
